Stirling Farmers' Market Policies

1. Each vendor must be on the market premises and ready to sell their product at 8:00am. Vendors are required to stay the entire day.
2. All items being sold must be locally grown, hand crafted or hand produced. No produce shall be purchased from an outside vendor (this includes but is not limited to other produce vendors and grocery stores). Local businesses may have a stand/booth in the market as long as it doesn't compete with a "local product" vendor. The BIA has the right to refuse a vendor that is deemed not suitable for the farmers' market.
3. Vendors agree to accept full responsibility for any loss, damage or accident occurring on the market as a result of negligence or wilful default on the part of the vendor.
6. Smoking is not allowed within the market perimeter.
7. Please leave your pets at home.
8. Vendors are responsible for their cash box or float.
9. Bathroom facilities will be provided for the season.
10. All vendors should work cooperatively with each other.
11. The market will be situated on the covered bridge and on the north and south side of the bridge. Vendor spaces will be assigned for the season on a first come basis. All parking spaces to will be reserved for customer parking only, with the exception of a few closest to the covered bridge.
12. Each vendor agrees to keep their area clean and tidy at all times and must cleanup their stand/booth before leaving the market at the end of the market day.
