Speakers' Biographies

Kathie Orr

Kathie Orr UE is a graduate of the University of Western Ontario (specializing in Canadian history). Employed for many years in the publishing industry she now works as a genealogical researcher and speaker. She is a long time OGS member, a Trustee & Past-President of the Toronto Branch, United Empire Loyalists' Association of Canada, a founding member and Director of APOLROD (Association for the Preservation of Ontario Land Registry Office Documents), a member of the Association of Professional Genealogists, and a former Board Member of The Friends of the Archives of Ontario. She taught courses at the Archives on subjects such as Introduction to the Archives of Ontario, Land Records Pre & Post Patent, Other Court Records, Records of the Heir & Devisee Commissions and the Records of the Civil and Provincial Secretary.

She teaches multi part courses in Basic Genealogy, Intermediate Genealogy, Loyalist Research, and Pre 1850 Ontario Sources. She speaks on topics such as an Introduction to the Archives of Ontario, Ontario Land Records Pre & Post Patent, Other Court Records, the Records of the Heir & Devisee Commissions, the Records of the Civil and Provincial Secretary, and Primary, Secondary and Hearsay Evidence.

Paul McGrath

Paul McGrath is a professional genealogist and researcher who specializes in exploring early Ontario and Toronto roots. He is currently the staff genealogist for, and appears in, the family history television show *Ancestors in the Attic* (now in its second season) on History Television. He hosts the popular website www.OntarioRoots.com which includes several free databases. Paul also serves as Chair of the Toronto Branch of the Ontario Genealogical Society (he was recently elected as Chair for 2008-2009).
