

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STIRLING-RAWDON

BY-LAW NO. 1249-18

ENTITLED a by-law to name persons to Committees of the Whole for the term of Council.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient for the efficient transaction of Township business to appoint persons to deal with the matters of the Corporation of the Township of Stirling-Rawdon;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that Township business be dealt with in Committee of the Whole;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STIRLING-RAWDON ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** the Committee of the Whole shall meet on the following dates and times to discuss the following matters:
 - i) Environmental – 1st Tuesday of each month at 9:00 a.m.
 - ii) Transportation– 1st Tuesday of each month immediately following the Environmental Committee meeting.
 - iii) Protection to Persons & Property– 4th Tuesday of each month at 9:00 a.m.
 - iv) Finance & Personnel – 4th Tuesday of each month immediately following the Environmental Committee meeting.
 - v) Planning and Development Advisory – 2nd Tuesday at 7 p.m.

2. **THAT** the following persons be appointed to Chair the following Committee of the Whole meetings:
 - i) Environmental – John Rock
 - ii) Transportation – Jeremy Solmes
 - iii) Protection to Persons & Property – Sari Watson
 - iv) Finance & Personnel – Grant Hagerman
 - v) Planning and Development Advisory – Bob Mullin

3. **THAT** this by-law shall come into full force and effect on and after the passing hereof and that all by-laws inconsistent with this by-law are hereby repealed.
