

**MINUTES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STIRLING-RAWDON SPECIAL COUNCIL
MEETING HELD ON MONDAY, MARCH 26, 2019 AT 9:00 A.M.**

Integrated Community Sustainability Plan

Council members in turn spoke of their priorities and goals to be accomplished in this term of Council.

Councillor Watson stated that environmental concerns are her top priority and would like to see a “Green committee” formed to take on the many environmental challenges the Township is facing.

Councillor Solmes noted his first priority is maintenance of our roads and infrastructure (including urban streets and storm sewers).

Councillor Rock provided a list of top ten priorities the most important being Belleville Road, East Front Street and Mill Street be repaved and brought up to standards in accordance with the Asset Management Plan.

Deputy Mayor Hagerman said that one thing on his wish list that had not been mentioned is the need for a recreation centre, large enough for an indoor walking trail and capable of seating at least 200 people.

Mayor Mullin added that he would like to see the walking trail system and proposed parks filled in and completed.

Many other goals were mentioned, Mayor Mullin asked that staff combine the individual lists on a chart to be prioritized at a future meeting.

There was an open discussion on what could be posted on the website to allow residents who cannot attend meetings to be knowledgeable about the business of the Township.
