

The Corporation of The Township of Stirling-Rawdon

By-Law No. 06-2026

A by-law to appoint Grant Hagerman to fill the vacant office of Ward 1 Councillor of the Township of Stirling-Rawdon for the remaining term of Council

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Stirling-Rawdon on December 16, 2025 via resolution SRR-251216-7 declared the office of one (1) Ward 1 Councillor vacant in accordance with Section 262 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Stirling-Rawdon deems it expedient to appoint a person to fill the vacancy of Ward 1 Councillor pursuant to Section 263 (1) (a) and Section 263 (5) (1) (i) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended; and

Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Stirling-Rawdon on January 13, 2026 passed resolution SRR-260113-27 to appoint Grant Hagerman to fill the vacant Ward 1 Councillor seat pursuant to Section 263 (1) (a) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended;

Now Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Stirling-Rawdon enacts as follows:

1. That Grant Hagerman be appointed to fulfill the vacant office of Ward 1 Councillor pursuant to Section 263 (1) (a) and Section 263 (5) (1) (i) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended;
2. That Grant Hagerman shall hold the office of Ward 1 Councillor for the remainder of the current term of Council pursuant to Section 264 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended; and
3. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect on final passing thereof.
