The nomination period for Township Council and school board trustee positions is now open as of Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Running for municipal office is a meaningful way to make a difference in the community.

Nominations in the Township of Stirling-Rawdon for the 2026 Municipal Election, which will be held on Monday, October 26, 2026, will be accepted for the following list of elected offices by completing the prescribed form in the Office of the Clerk, 2529 Stirling-Marmora Road, Stirling, ON K0K 3E0 between May 1, 2026 and August 20, 2026 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on Nomination Day, Friday, August 21, 2026 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

**Please make an appointment with the Returning Officer to file your nomination.**

The required filing fee for the Head of Council is \$200.00 and all other offices are \$100.00 (cash, debit, certified cheque, or money order) made payable to the Township of Stirling-Rawdon.

Individuals who wish to be a candidate in the upcoming election cannot solicit or accept contributions for election purposes or incur campaign expenses until a nomination paper has been filed. Full details on the procedures to be followed may be obtained from the Returning Officer.
