

Schedule "A" to By-law No. 1210-18

Please Note 1000 litres = 1 cubic metre

The following service charges applies to all properties and includes 8000 litres:

Residential House:	Water Service Charge	= \$37.68 per month
	Sewer Service Charge	= \$19.03 per month
All Apartment Units:	Water Service Charge	= \$28.26 per month
	Sewer Service Charge	= \$14.27 per month
All Commercial/Industrial Users:	Water Service Charge	= \$28.26 per month
	Sewer Service Charge	= \$14.27 per month

For any usage over and above 8000 litres the following rates shall apply:

Water - \$1.59 per 1000 litres between 8001 litres and 28000 litres
\$0.81 per 1000 litres between 28001 litres and 48000 litres
\$0.40 per 1000 litres between 48001 litres and 78000 litres
\$0.19 per 1000 litres between 78001 litres and 778000 litres
Sewer - \$2.40 per 1000 litres between 8001 litres and 28000 litres
\$1.16 per 1000 litres between 28001 litres and 48000 litres
\$0.58 per 1000 litres between 48001 litres and 78000 litres
\$0.30 per 1000 litres between 78001 litres and 778000 litres

All Properties will be charged a **Capital Investment Fund Fee** of \$28.33 per month for approximately 10 years as long as no additional capital has to be undertaken and/or financed.

Water Repairs and Temporary Hook-ups:

If the Township needs to hook-up to your house for a temporary hook-up then the Township will read your meter at the time of temporary hook-up. Your bill going forward until the temporary connection is removed will be ½ the average of your previous three months. If below the 8000 litres or 8 cubic metres then the regular service charge will apply only.

If your house needs a temporary hook-up because of a water leak on your system then we will read your meter at the time of the hook-up. Your bill going forward until the temporary connection is removed will be the full average of the previous three months.

Properties without a Meter:

If your house or business doesn't have a meter then you will be charged the provincial average of usage, which is 270 litre per day per person. The Canadian Census for Stirling-Rawdon shows that there are an average 1.94 people per home in the urban area. Therefore your home or business will be charged the following:

2 x 270 litres x 30 days per month = 16200 litres or 16.2 cubic metres per month with the first 8000 litres covered in the regular service charge, the additional 8200 litres will be charged out at the rate prescribed.
