Zoning By-law Amendment

The purpose of this by-law is to rezone approximately 199 acres of land legally described as Part Lot 24, Concession 11, Township of Stirling-Rawdon from the “Permanent Agricultural (PA)” to the Marginal Agriculture (MA) Zone to recognize changes made to the Official Plan. This re-zoning is a condition of severance B41/19. **Note: “Environmental Protection (EP)” zone shall remain unchanged.**

The Secretary advised that notice of the meeting was given to all persons and agencies entitled to receive notice on August 16, 2019.

The Secretary advised that no written submissions concerning the proposed rezoning have been received.

The Chair asked if anyone present wished to give a verbal or written presentation. A neighbor, Mr. Smith, asked for clarification. The Chairman noted that the rezoning was a condition of severance required by Hastings County to recognize the change in the Official Plan.
