## **Reopening of Council Chambers**

As the Province of Ontario has now moved to Step Three of the Roadmap to Reopen, we will be reopening Council Chambers to the public as of August 1, 2021.

Based on the provincial regulations allowing no more than 25 persons at an indoor event, and allowing for social distancing, there will be a maximum of 6 members of the public allowed to attend at this time.

Anyone wishing to attend Committee/Council meetings in person will be required to call the municipal office to register. This may be done by calling the Clerk or Deputy Clerk by 3:30 pm on the Monday before Committee meetings or the Monday of a Council meeting. Please note that registration will be on a first come first serve basis.

Attendees will be required to fill out a COVID-19 screening form on arrival and must be masked. Once the meeting has started attendees must remain seated, quiet and respectful of the meeting and those in attendance.
